Rabies Surveillance in South Dakota, 2017 In 2017, 22 animals tested positive for rabies (Table 1), a 19% decrease from 2016 (27 positives) These 22 rabid animals included 10 domestic animals (4 cattle, 3 dogs, 2 cats, and 1 goat) and 12 wild animals (8 skunks, 3 ...
